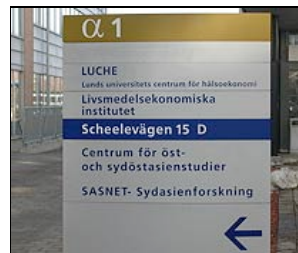
The office is manned: Weekdays 9–17.
