

Introduction to the electronic edition of the Census of India

The Census of India (Indiens statistik) is now accessible in electronic form on CD or via the internet, but only few Danish scholars utilise those facilities due to the complicity of the Census tables which works in Excell.

The course will give a short introduction to the form and tables of the Census of India, and demonstrate how to utilize the electronic version of the Census.
