## Call for Panel Proposals:

The 19th European Conference on Modern South Asian Studies (19th ECMSAS) will be held in Leiden, the Netherlands from 27-30 June 2006. The conference is hosted by the International Institute for Asian Studies and Prof. D.H.A. Kolff will act as convenor.

Panel proposals for the 19th ECMSAS should be submitted to the Conference Secretariat before 1 June 2005 by email in Rich Text Format (RTF) or PDF. The proposal should include a title, an abstract of 300 words, and contact information of the panel organizer (name, address, email, affiliation, and title).

The Academic Advisory Committee, represented by the board of the European Association for South Asian Studies and selected Dutch researchers, will then review the panel proposals. Notices of acceptance will be sent out by August 2005. The accepted panel proposals will be listed in the IIAS Newsletter and on the conference website.
