

Join us on an Election Trip to India 9 - 17 May!

India is holding parliamentary elections this spring. Form your own view of the complex and fast-growing India. Join Springtime on an Election Trip to the world's largest and most colorful democracy.

Will Congress stay or will BJP come into power? Or will the challenger Mayawati, a dalit woman and chief minister of Uttar Pradesh, become prime minister? What will happen to Rahul Gandhi? And will the communists keep playing a pivotal role in the balance of national politics?

What will the consequences of the elections be for business, and for Swedish enterprises? Will India open up for more liberalisations or turn towards protectionism?

Election Trip 9 - 17 May

714 million Indians are heading to the polling booths in April and May to elect the 15th parliament, Lok Sabha, since Indian Independence. The last election day is May 13 and the results will be presented on May 16.

On this our election trip, we visit a local state to see how local campaigning up front and to visit the polling booths. We then go to Delhi to meet members of parliament, politicians, media and business representatives during a custom-made two-day conference. We end with a common election night party to follow the announcement of the election results.

We fly out on May 9, visit local campaigns on May 11 - 13, spend May 14 - 16 in Delhi, and return back on 17 May. (You can also opt to attend just the conference part in Delhi on 14 - 16 May.)

Before the trip we hold two seminars in Stockholm. We present Indian politics and business, and discuss today's India with specially invited guest speakers.

The cost for the entire program, including roundtrip flights Sweden - India, program, singleroom hotel and domestic transports, is **37.500 SEK** .
