## **Request for Emergency Assistance for Sri Lanka**

It is with much sadness that I am contacting you today. I never thought that the information I would be communicating to you would be on something like this.....

As you are aware, widespread devastation and loss of life have been caused mainly in the Eastern and Southern parts of Sri Lanka as a result of a tidal wave (tsunami) which occurred last morning (26<sup>th</sup> December 2004 morning) in the Indian Ocean. Sri Lanka has never experienced a disaster of this magnitude in its entire history.

Initial reports indicate that thousands have been killed and many more remain missing. The number of affected people is approximately one million.

The government of Sri Lanka has declared this a national disaster and all the Government and other agencies have been placed on an emergency footing to operationalize rescue, relief, medical and other assistance in the affected areas.

As for the tourists, all necessary steps are being taken to provide alternative accommodation. Information regarding tourists in the island's coastal belt is being provided round the clock on the Hotline 0094-112-437061 set up by the Sri Lanka Tourist Board, which is also keeping all foreign missions based in Colombo fully informed to facilitate speedy responses to inquires on tourists. Sri Lanka is also experiencing an influx of tourists from neighbouring countries affected by the tidal waves for emergency accommodation.

The Sri Lankan Government is appealing the International community and Sri Lankan expatriates for the following assistance in kind:

Immediate:

- 1. Tents, blankets, linen etc.,
- 2. Food (pre cooked or ready to eat meal packs)
- 3. Water purification tablets (approximately 2 million)
- 4. Wheat flour, pulses, rice
- 5. Drugs, paracetamol, anti-biotic, dressing, suture material, disposable syringes.

- 6. Intravenous infusions (saline and dextrose)
- 7. Portable generators

## Medium term:

- 1. Housing and rehabilitation
- 2. Reconstruction of infrastructure

Further details of the medium term requirements shall follow.
