“Veda and Tantra are the twin scriptural sources of the philosophy, religion and culture of India. In order to know the truth of Indian spirit, it is necessary to become aware of the Tantric wisdom along with the Vedic-Upanishadic thought. Tantra complements Veda in a number of ways in all the three areas of philosophy (i) epistemology (theory of knowledge), (ii) ontology (theory of reality) and (iii) axiology (theory of values).”
