After the meeting (from 17.00), everybody is welcome to join us for snacks and refreshments in the foyer at Kårhuset, two stairs above from Hörsalen.

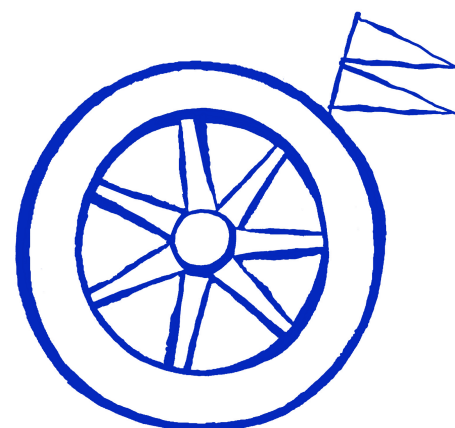
