FOURTH INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON TAMIL EPIGRAPHY **17 to 28 September 2007, Paris**

We are pleased to announce our fourth international workshop on Tamil Epigraphy. The twoweek workshop (**17 to 28 September 2007**) will explore the techniques of reading and interpretation of Tamil inscriptions. The historical and multidisciplinary importance of inscriptions will be highlighted. This workshop is intended for students and researchers who have little or no previous experience with the discipline.

Course coordinator: Appasamy MURUGAIYAN (EPHE-SHP) Lectures will be given in English.

AGENDA:

Classes will be held from Monday till Friday, morning 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. (Lunch break) and afternoon 14.00 to 16.30 p.m.

First session: Introduction to Tamil epigraphy, introduction to Grantha writing system and the evolution of scripts in Tamil, issues in Tamil and Dravidian historical linguistics.

Second session: Will focus on reading and interpretation of selected inscriptions from Chola, Pallava and Pandya dynasties (7th to 16th centuries). Importance of inscriptions as source materials will be highlighted. Emphasis will be given to religious, historical and social issues that are raised in the various types of inscriptions. On the basis of different types of texts light will be shed upon the linguistic features of each one illustrating the corresponding morphological and syntactical characteristics. The affinity of inscriptional language with the Modern Tamil language will be considered. Some attention will be given to the philological study of the personal names. We will arrange special lectures in the afternoon on topics related to Tamil and South Indian studies by invited specialists.
